HEALTH PROMOTION AS A ROLE FOR NURSE

Introduction

1. Health

Every nursing model defines health in relation to the overall model and requires specific approaches to the patient. Thus, there are several different acceptable definitions. However, a commonly cited definition is that of the world Health Organization (WHO, 1958): "Health is a state of complete physical, mental, and social well-being not merely the absence of disease and infirmity." This definition is an acknowledgment that health is more than non-disease.

The Orem Self-Care model of nursing is very appropriate for nurses to use as a vehicle for health promotion. Orem (1959) has defined that the health is a state of wholeness or integrity. Capacity to like as a human being within our physical, biological and social environment achieving life potential.

2. Health Promotion

Health promotion is related to changing life style behaviors, which could the damaging to health or to changing behaviors which could lead to maximizing health and functioning.

Qtawa charter (WHO, 1986) defines health promotion as 'the process of enabling people to increase control over and improve their health."

3. Role for Nurse

in Nepal, health promotion is seen as a role for nurses, with the emphasis very much on child health, although the health promotion needs of the elderly have become increasingly improvement.

Health promotion can, emphasized however, integrated in to all setting where nurses work. Health promotion is a activity that is deliberately planned and purposefully directed towards increasing a person's ability to function and facilitating a maximal state of physical, mental and social well-being. It is not directed solely to the "well being" who want to be at a higher level, but to people who need their health restored from an illness and all stages in between. The ultimate goal of health promotion actively by nurses is for the patient to active self-sustaining optimal levels of function and well-being. At this level, people do not need nursing or other professional health care. They have achieved a healthy and harmonious life-style and they are able to manage their self-care.

After a through assessment, that the level may be reached buy the nursing interventions to assist the patient in achievement of three main goals.

- Health restoration: Adaptation and crisis resolution for people experiencing some health threat or health deficit.
- Health maintenance and life-style modification: Health stabilization for people with chronic condition, risk reduction and health protection for people without identified illness.
- Health status Monitoring: Confirmation of health through periodic assessment, teaching and reinforcement of self-directed health promotion activities.

By using this goal, health promotion may occur in any setting: although the nurse must always consider the social factors, which affect the patient's health, these may not be so apparent in hospital. Hospitalized patients even in critical care may benefit from a health promotion intervention. For Example, the nurse could support a middle aged female and help her family adapt to the crisis of a myocardial infraction The Second level of the goals involve stabilization which may also occur in a tertiary setting and risk reduction which may be in the hospital or the community. Health status verification may occur in occupational health and community settings.

Conclusion: A change has occurred in the personal relations between nurse and patients, away from the view of the health professional as the expert who always knows what is best for the patient.
