## Percutaneous Transvenous Mitral Commissurotomy: SGNHC Experience

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One hundred patients had PTMC from June 2003 to January 2004, Seventy four percent of them were female. Youngest was 10 years and oldest was 5 8 years, Mean age was 25 years. Under 21 years were 26%, Atrial fibrillation was present in 32%,

Mean MVA increased from range 0.91 cm2 to 1.90 cm2 with range of 0.5 cm? preprocedure to 2.3 cm2 post-procedure, Left atrial mean pressure decreased from average 19 mm Hg to 6 mm Hg. Subjective improvement was reported in 99%. There was no mortality. Significant MR (>2 Grade) was noted in 3 patients (3%) post- procedure. None developed severe MR. Procedure failed in two patients. None had cardiac tamponade. None had to undergo emergency surgery. One had systemic embolisation during the procedure which recovered subsequently.
