

Indexing is not merely a badge; it is a bridge connecting local insights to global solutions: experience from six years of editorial process

– Indexing Journey of JKAHS from Google Scholar to Hinari under R4L Portal.

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ABSTRACT

This editorial chronicle the systematic indexing trajectory of the Journal of Karnali Academy of Health Sciences (JKAHS) from 2018–2025. As the first premier diamond open-access health sciences journal of Karnali Province of Nepal, JKAHS achieved sequential integration into six major indexing platforms: Google Scholar (2019), Nepal Journals Online (Nep-JOL, 2020), Index Copernicus (2020), J-Gate and JournalTOCs (2021), Crossref (2022), Directory of Open Access Journals (DOAJ, 2024), and HINARI (2024). Each platform has contributed uniquely –improving discoverability, regional outreach, metadata interoperability, open-access credibility, and equitable access for resource-limited settings– thereby reinforcing JKAHS’s mission to disseminate high-impact biomedical research. The indexing milestone is analyzed for its technical requirements, strategic value, and impact on the journal’s global visibility, academic credibility, and alignment with institutional mandates for equitable knowledge dissemination. Data demonstrate increase in submissions and citation growth post-indexing. The journal’s archiving infrastructure and zero-fee publishing model are highlighted as critical enablers. Challenges in sustaining indexing compliance and future pathways toward Scopus, Web of Science and MEDLINE/PubMed inclusion are also discussed. This article reflects on our indexing journey from Google Scholar to Hinari, shedding light on the challenges, strategies, and outcomes of this transformative process.

BACKGROUND

In the rapidly evolving world of academic publishing, indexing has long been regarded as a hallmark of credibility and quality. For any journal, achieving the desired status of being indexed in recognized databases such as Google Scholar, PubMed, Scopus, or Hinari, can be seen as a moment of accomplishment [1]. However, the significance of indexing extends far beyond mere recognition; it serves as a crucial bridge that connects local knowledge, research, and innovations with global audiences and solutions. The journey of the Journal of Karnali Academy of Health Sciences (JKAHS) in this regard is a story of commitment, growth, and the pursuit of excellence. Over the past seven years, the editorial team has worked tirelessly to ensure that our research reaches not only local but also international platforms [2].

JKAHS is a peer-reviewed, open-access scholarly journal that has been published triannually since its inception in 2018 [3] releasing in the month of January–April, May–August, and September–December in print (pISSN 2616-0064) and online (eISSN 2676-1327) versions [4], with a DOI prefix (10.61814/jkajs and 10.3126/jakhs) from Crossref [5] and NLM ID (101761061) from National Library of Medicine (NLM) Catalog of NCBI [6].

JKAHS was founded with the vision of showcasing health research emanating from the Karnali region of Nepal by Prof. Dr. Rajendra Raj Wagle (then Vice-Chancellor) and Prof. Dr. Modnath Marahatta (then Dean). The region, known for its geographical remoteness and socio-economic challenges, faces a myriad of health-related issues that often go unnoticed in the global academic arena. JKAHS has consistently strived to amplify its global footprint since its inception in 2018. As we celebrated our 7th year, I reflect on a pivotal aspect of our growth: our journey through indexing milestones. From our earliest inclusion in Google Scholar to our recent acceptance into Hinari, each step has fortified our mission to democratize scientific knowledge and elevate healthcare research in Nepal’s remote regions.

TIMELINE OF INDEXING

The history of indexing journey began after I joined editorial team as editor in 2018 and then managing editor and executive editor in 2019. The founding editorial team under the leadership of Prof. Dr. Modnath Marahatta, and other dedicated team of editors started the journal in 2018 and release its very first issue (Vol. 1, No. 1, Jan-Apr Issue 1) in May 2018. Subsequently issue 2 and 3 with released under the leadership of Dr. Binod Aryal as chief

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editor, and issue 4 and issue 5 were published under the leadership of Prof. Dr. Kiran Regmi. In 2020, I received the responsibility of Editor-in-Chief. Until that time JKAHS didn't have digital object identifier (DOI). Our dedicated team of editors (Table 2 - 5) worked day-and-night to make the editorial process transparent by adopting the open Journal system (OJS), supported by public knowledge project (PKP). After incorporating the editorial process fully through the OJS, JKAHS was indexed in Google Scholar in 2019 [7]. Then we applied indexing of NepJol [8], and start getting DOI from under NepJol domain (10.3126/jkahs). In 2022, with initiation of Nepal health research council (NHRC), NepalMedline (NepMed) had started with aim of indexing all medical journal of Nepal, and JKAHS was indexed in NepMed in 2022 [9].

After getting DOI from NepJol, our path for further indexing was open. Thereafter, we applied JKAHS to be indexed in IndexCopernicus in 2020 [10], JournalTOCs [11], and Semantic Scholar in 2021 [12]. After that we applied for directory of open access journal (DOAJ), unfortunately, we got rejected twice. Meantime, we realized that we need to have our own DOI. We applied for CrossRef, and in 2023 we received our own DOI (10.61814/jkahs) [5] under the direct sponsorship from global equitable membership (GEM) program [13]. In 2024 after Dr. Lok Raj Joshi joined JKAHS as managing editor, we again applied for DOAJ indexing, and finally

accepted to be indexed in DOAJ as the diamond open access journal [15]. Indexing with Hinari at the end of 2024 further motivate our dedicated editorial team to work further in the journey of quality publication and better dissemination of its published articles [16].

Google Scholar in 2019

Google Scholar is a free search engine that indexes the full text or metadata of scholarly literature across an array of publishing formats and disciplines, providing citation metrics such as h-index and i10-index for authors and their publications [7].

Our inaugural indexing achievement was Google Scholar in 2019, a platform that granted JKAHS immediate global visibility. From the first issue (Vol.1 | No.1 | Issue 1 (Jan-Apr 2018) to 22 issue (Vol. 8 | No.1 | Issue 22 (Jan-Apr 2025), JKAHS has published in total 375 articles out of which 262 (70%) is original research articles (Table 1). As of end of May 2025, JKAHS has garnered 640 citations [7], validating its content's relevance and impact on clinical practice and public health discourse. Inclusion in Google Scholar significantly broadened JKAHS's reach, facilitating automated harvesting by reference managers and enhancing the journal's citation visibility among researchers in diverse fields.

Nepal Journal Online (NepJOL) in 2020

NepJOL is managed by the Tribhuvan University Central Library and hosted by Ubiquity Press. Launched in 2007,

its objective is to give greater visibility to Nepal-published journals by providing access to tables of contents, abstracts, and full texts online [9]. In 2020, JKAHS was indexed in NepJOL, integrating the journal into a national repository that consolidates Nepal's scholarly output. Inclusion in NepJOL strengthened JKAHS's domestic accessibility, ensuring that scholars, policymakers, and practitioners within Nepal's academic and health sectors could readily engage with its content and reference its findings in local research and policy development [9].

Index Copernicus in 2020

Recognition by Index Copernicus (IC)—a global database emphasizing methodological rigor—affirmed JKAHS's compliance with international publishing standards [10]. This inclusion bolstered our credibility among European and Asian researchers. Also in 2020, JKAHS was added to the ICI Journals Master List, signaling compliance with IC's indexing criteria and extending the journal's presence among institutions that consult IC for journal discovery [10].

CrossRef in 2022

Until 2022 JKAHS received DOI under the NepJol domain (10.3126/jkabs). We secured a unique DOI prefix (10.61814/jkabs) [5] of JKAHS from Vol. 5, No. 3, Sep-Dec Issue 15; 2022 onwards, through the Global Equitable Membership (GEM) Program [13]. This upgrade standardized article identification, improved metadata quality, and integrated JKAHS into Crossref's API ecosystem for sustained interoperability ensuring permanent article preservation, which are critical for academic integrity [14].

Crossref membership allows JKAHS to steward rich metadata records—linking funding information, contributors, and inter-article references—thereby enhancing discoverability and enabling services such as “Cited By” tracking and similarity checks [14].

Directory of Open Access Journals (DOAJ) in 2024

DOAJ certification in 2024 validated our commitment to diamond open access (zero fee for author and reader). This milestone amplified our reach to policymakers, educators, and Global South researchers, aligning with KAHs's equity mandate [15]. JKAHS was accepted into DOAJ in late 2023 and officially listed as of January 16, 2024, confirming the journal's adherence to best practices in open-access publishing and signaling its credibility to librarians and funding bodies worldwide [15]. DOAJ listing enhances JKAHS's visibility among open-access advocates and ensures indexing by institutional repositories and discovery services that integrate DOAJ metadata.

Hinari in 2024

Our 2024 inclusion in Hinari, under WHO's Research4Life program, epitomizes our inclusivity mission. Hinari, the Health Internetwork Access to Research Initiative under Research4Life, is operated by the World Health Organization and partners [16]. Launched in 2001, Hinari provides free or low-cost access to peer-reviewed biomedical and social science literature for institutions in low- and middle-income countries. Hinari inclusion fulfills JKAHS's equity goals by extending its research to underserved regions, fostering evidence-based practice, and supporting capacity building in health systems. It enables clinicians, educators, and policymakers in

resource-limited settings, including Nepal, to access its articles without subscription barriers.

CHALLENGES IN SUSTAINING INDEXING COMPLIANCE

Each indexing milestone we have achieved has reinforced the journal's mission to disseminate high-quality biomedical knowledge, ensuring that JKAHS remains a cornerstone of health sciences research in Nepal and beyond. While celebrating these milestones, we acknowledge challenges discussed hereunder:

1. Maintaining academic integrity with rigorous editorial and peer-review process

Journals must demonstrate consistent, high-quality peer review to satisfy indexing bodies' quality criteria, yet novice or non-indexed journals often struggle with reviewer recruitment and retention [17]. Maintaining the scientific quality of any journal depends on the editorial and peer-review integrity. The Web of Science Core Collection applies 24 quality criteria focused on editorial rigor, and failure to uphold these can lead to delisting [17, 18]. Scopus similarly relies on an expert Content Selection & Advisory Board to evaluate editorial practices, making lapses in peer-review transparency a significant risk for exclusion [18, 19].

2. Ensuring Regularity and Timeliness of Publication

Indexing platforms require consistent issue frequency and on-time publication. Scopus may reject journals that fail to publish regularly or miss scheduled issues [19]. Likewise, MEDLINE mandates that indexed journals supply citations within six months of final publication; delays or backlogs can jeopardize continued indexing [20].

3. Technical and Metadata Compliance

Accurate and complete metadata—such as author affiliations, ORCID, disclosure of conflict of interest, funding source, abstracts, and keywords—is essential for automated harvesting by indexing services. Inadequate metadata can lead to indexing delays or omissions in Scopus and PubMed Central [21–23]. Technical inconsistencies, including incorrect ISSNs or DOI assignment issues, further threaten compliance.

4. Safeguarding Against Publication Misconduct

The proliferation of “paper mills” and fraudulent submissions poses a critical threat: journals must implement robust screening to detect manipulated or plagiarized manuscripts, or risk delisting [19, 21]. Wiley's closure of multiple journals due to large-scale research fraud underscores this vulnerability. Scopus has reported challenges with hijacked or predatory journals, demanding vigilance in editorial oversight [24, 25].

5. Demonstrating Citation Impact

Especially for inclusion in Web of Science's Science Citation Index (SCI), journals must evidence citation performance and influence in their fields. Achieving quartile rankings (e.g., Q1/Q2/Q3 and Q4) is challenging for new or regional journals lacking extensive citation networks [24]. Without visible impact metrics, applications to Web of Science and Scopus may be deferred or rejected [26, 27].

By systematically addressing these challenges and following targeted pathways, the journal can position itself for successful inclusion in Scopus, Web of Science, and MEDLINE/PubMed, thereby enhancing its international visibility, credibility, and impact.

WAY FORWARD

Sustaining indexing compliance for scholarly journals involves upholding rigorous editorial and technical standards, maintaining regular publication schedules, and safeguarding publication integrity against issues like fraudulent submissions and inconsistent metadata. Future inclusion in Scopus, Web of Science, and MEDLINE/PubMed requires targeted strategies—such as meeting specific selection criteria, demonstrating citation impact, and ensuring technical quality—to align JKAHS with the expectations of each indexing body.

Indexing is more than just a mark of prestige or recognition. Indexing serves as a critical bridge connecting local health insights from local regions to global health solutions. It enables local knowledge to inform broader discussions, contributes to global health policies, nurtures collaborations, and enhances the impact of research. The visibility gained through indexing amplifies the voices of local researchers, ensures that their work is taken into account on the world stage, and helps in creating inclusive, sustainable health solutions that are informed by both global and local realities. Together, we turn isolation into innovation. Indexing is not merely a badge; it is a bridge connecting local insights to global solutions.
